Dear Faculty,

We apologize for the confusion that occurred yesterday with some students notifying you that they

were locked out of the LMS. For some background, students were provided several reminders to

complete their vaccination self-certification prior to this control technique being implemented. This

included two general emails from the Vice President of Student Affairs as well as targeted messages

to non-compliant students via a Blackboard Connect message (phone call and email), individualized

push notifications and later individual phone calls.

Rather than disenrolling the remaining approximate 1,000 non-compliant students, a decision was

made to block access to Blackboard and Canvas, and to put a hold on their PeopleSoft accounts. A

message was sent to these students yesterday on why the block was placed and what they need to

do to regain access. We will continue to reach out to the 594 students who remain non-compliant.

In retrospect, we should have informed you prior to implementation. We realize now that you were

impacted and apologize for any inconvenience. Please know that campus safety is our priority and

we will continue to implement measures for the health and safety of all our constituents. Thank you

for your continued understanding.
