## How to Access myCAP & PAWS Report (Students)

myCAP is an academic planning tool designed for students to strategize their course selections throughout their academic journey. You have the option to initiate planning either independently or in collaboration with your advisor. Should you choose to plan independently, it's crucial to seek input from your advisor or the program coordinator for feedback. On the other hand, the PAWS report serves as an automated credit summary. It furnishes students with a comprehensive list of all coursework necessary for graduation from CSUSB.

Here are the steps on how to access myCAP and PAWS Report:

1. Start by logging into your MyCoyote account. Navigate to the "My Academics" section.



2. Under "My Academics," you'll find options for myCAP and PAWS Report.
